- Proposals should include:
 - (1) Title of proposal
 - (2) A brief description of the proposed presentation or panel
 - (3) Presenter's or panel members' name(s), institutional affiliation, and position

- Proposal Deadline: Saturday, February 8, 2019. Proposals will be reviewed by the SOSU AAUP Chapter Conference Committee and proposal authors will be notified by February 13th as to the proposal's acceptance.
- Some funding may be available to help defray travel costs for those presenters who travel over 100 miles to Durant.
